## Saint-Nicolas at the EFDB

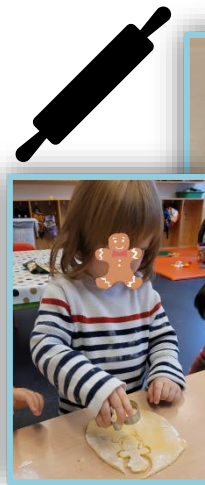
On Friday, December 6, 2024, the bells of Saint Nicholas rang out at the EFDB.
