The children made the most of the fine weather this spring with numerous outings, including the wide open spaces of the Grün80.

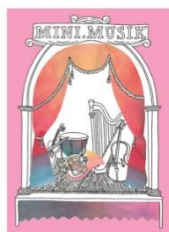




Chronicle from the Kindergarten

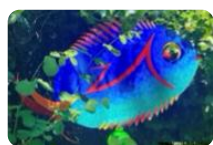
"DER GROSSE RABATZ"

This month, **CP** and **CE1** pupils took part in the competition, each receiving an "Excellent" diploma.



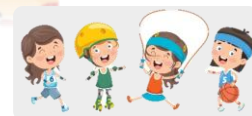
