Once again this year, the 6th-grade students had the opportunity to visit the National Assembly in Paris and represent the EFDB there.

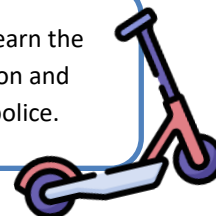


They had the privilege of spending the day alongside Mr. Marc Ferracci.

Handball Tournament

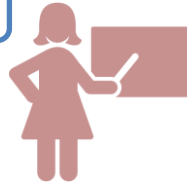
As they do every year, the CM1, CM2' and 6th-grade students participated in the "Grands Stades" tournament in Saint-Louis.
